



Torrent Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2019

Located in the heart of the Nelson Region, Anchorage Wines is a family owned winery, who hold firmly the belief that the rich fertile soils surrounding the Motueka township, coupled with balmy sea breezes and some of New Zealand's consistently highest sunshine readings are the ideal climate in which to craft their aromatic wines. Grapes from our vineyards in the nearby Moutere add a further dimension to our range of classic aromatic varieties.

The Sauvignon Blanc was machine harvested in the cool mornings of late March, then destemmed and gently pressed to tank for settling. The juice was then racked off solids and the bright juice cool fermented with aromatic yeast strains. The wine was then blended and bottled for you to enjoy!

Our Sauvignon Blanc has aromas of passionfruit and lime citrus. The palate is clear and fresh with an abundance of citrus characters. Balanced acidity with generous mouthfeel leads into a long finish.

Chilled as is, after a hard days work, or with a tasty white meat dish like chicken, as well as delicious sea-food such as crayfish and scallops.
